

# The Enchanted Bigfoot Mini-Rally

May 2,3,4 2019 at Angel Fire RV Resort, New Mexico

New Mexico is called the Land of Enchantment for good reason. We will be staying at the [Angel Fire RV Resort](#) in Angel Fire, New Mexico, about a 30 minute drive from world famous [Taos, New Mexico](#). This new resort is a Good Sam park and one of the top-rated parks in New Mexico. And, regardless of [what you may have read](#), you don't need a passport to go here (unless you are from Canada or another foreign country). Several *Prevost* Clubs hold their rallies here which speaks highly of the attractiveness and desirability of this resort.

Northern New Mexico is home to a rich history spanning thousands of years. Our reason for picking the dates chosen is that May 3<sup>rd</sup> is the date of the [Santa Cruz Feast Day in Taos Pueblo](#). The feast day will include the Blessing of the Fields & Corn Dance. Taos Pueblo has been occupied continuously for over 1000 years so chances are there will be someone home for our visit. It may be possible for us to use one of the Angel Fire ski busses as a shuttle to the pueblo.

In addition to the [Taos Pueblo](#) and the [town of Taos](#) you will have the opportunity to see numerous other attractions in the area. You can tour other ancient [Indian dwellings](#), [futuristic Earthship homes](#), many National parks and monuments and more art galleries, museums and crafts than you can shake a stick at. Famous artist Marsden Hartley described the scenery in the area on his first visit to Taos in 1918. *"The country outside of Taos is simply too beautiful, I have never seen anything so lovely in my life. It is not the kind of thing I thought I would see... these long chains of blue grey mountains, and the miles of sagebrush plains in front of them, with here and there rising out of the sage in the distance, clear blue hills standing alone... and the most beautiful arroyos... and over all this acres of Blue sky. Well, I give you my word, I have never seen anything lovelier in my life. Taos is all that its name implies, 'richness', it is beautiful, and there was never a more beautiful single mountain than Taos Mountain."* If you have always wanted to visit New Mexico, this is a great place to start or end your tour. There is enough scenery and attractions close by to keep you busy all summer or longer.
